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NED University is moving naturally and pledged to become Carbon free by 2021



Our planet is experiencing unprecedented challenges in the present times. The extracting relationship exercised by the people with Earth is the foremost. NED University has been conscious of the foremost social responsibility to the mother Earth and has already begun a rigorous campaign of turning its campuses to a carbon neutral status. Planting trees and increasing efforts to minimize the use of fossil fuels on the campuses are two essential components of this multi-pronged approach. The NED University of Engineering & Technology in collaboration with the Institute of Engineers Pakistan is now making a focused effort of limiting the use of automobiles on the campus and replacing it by healthy option of mobility such as walking and cycling. Once a week, on every Friday for a period of one year; all the automobiles are restricted to the edge locations of the campuses according to a designated plan. Faculty, staff, students and visitors are invited to walk or cycle to their destinations and enjoy the NED University in its pristine flavour. The first such endeavor was initiated on 31st January, 2020 on all the three campuses in Karachi and the constituent college in Islamkot, Tharparkar. In continuation of "Healthy Friday", Barrister Murtaza Wahab, Advisor to the Chief Minister of Sindh also contributed towards this campaign to make the university a carbon neutral and cycled from main gate to the administration block of the NED University of Engineering & Technology on 7th February, 2020.

"We have protected the campus from 3.2 metric tones of carbon through carbon neutral practice and through the reduction of carbon footprint; the University has pledged to become carbon neutral by 2021".

"NED promotes green Sindh and green Pakistan and we would encourage to promote this ideology across Sindh".

NED University has developed its own low cost 'NED Ventilator'



Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak has created a global health crisis that has had a deep impact on the world as it has upended societies and dramatically altered everyday life across the globe. Pakistan, like the most countries in the world, is struggling to contain coronavirus. It has emerged as one of the countries with the fastest growing rate of coronavirus infections and also facing the shortage of health equipment, particularly ventilators.

To meet this challenge, Dr. Riaz Uddin, Director, Haptics, Human Robotics and Condition Monitoring Laboratory at NED University of Engineering & Technology has taken a significant step towards making Pakistan self-reliant in production of medical equipment and come up with a prototype of a ventilator out of scrap to help Pakistan deal with the outbreak. His team is putting the ventilator through its final test – clinical trials are likely to start this week before it goes into production phase. It can be run on both invasive and non-invasive situations on ICU

patients. Pakistan Engineering Council has permitted NED University of Engineering & Technology for the production of these ventilators on a large scale. Dr. Riaz Uddin said that "the idea of making a ventilator out of scrap struck his mind after the coronavirus outbreak in Pakistan". He further elaborated that "its price is very low as compared to the ventilators available in the international market and Pakistan could export this inexpensive ventilator, if the government cooperates to make it on a commercial level." The design received good coverage from international media such as BBC.

at City Campus attended the daylong event that comprised students' speeches, quizzes, parade, skits, documentaries.




