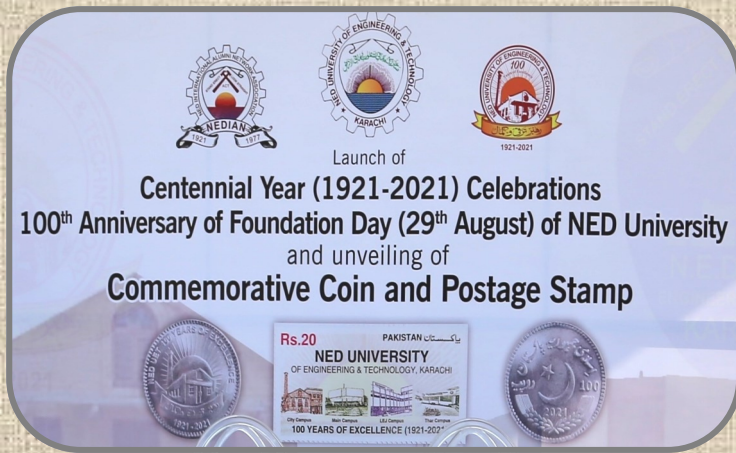

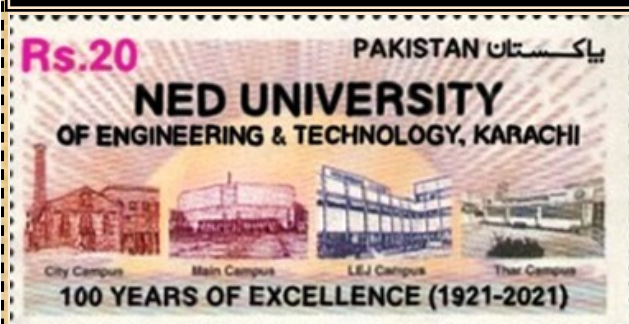

On the occasion of Centennial Year (1921-2021) of NED University, a ceremony was held on 29th August, 2021 in the City Campus of the University situated at Maulana Din Muhammad Wafai Road, Karachi. Unveiling of Commemorative Coin of Rs. 100/- issued by the State Bank of Pakistan and Postage Stamp of Rs. 20/- issued by the Government of Pakistan were commenced in the ceremony to embark the hundred year academic excellence of NED University of Engineering & Technology. The Prince of Wales College later NED University of Engineering and Technology was established on 29th August, 1921 by the British rulers through the support of local charitable donation by Dinshaw family. In Centennial Year 2021, due to the pandemic situation, a brief event was being held at the City Campus. Distinguished alumni

from around the world virtually participated in the event. Honourable Chief Minister of Sindh, Syed Murad Ali Shah was the Chief Guest of the event. In this occasion, Prof. Dr. Sarosh H. Lodi, Vice Chancellor said that “the issuance of commemorative coin and stamp by the Government of Pakistan is very commendable”. He appreciated every person associated with the varsity for playing their role in the development of the institution. He elaborated that “We want modern education and technology in the engineering sector, which is why our engineers are recognized nationally and internationally”.

1st International Conference on Applied Physics and Engineering (ICAPE-2021)

The 1st International Conference on Applied Physics and Engineering (ICAPE-2021) was organized by the Department of Physics, NED University of Engineering and Technology on 16-17 September, 2021. The aim of conference was to provide a platform for the researchers in academics, industries and research institutions for exchanging and upgrading their knowledge in different fields of Physics and Engineering.



The research presented in the conference was focused on five themes; Space Physics, Modelling and Simulation, Medical Physics, Electronics and Materials. In the conference a total of 62 papers were presented by the researchers from USA, UK, Canada, Kenya, Poland,

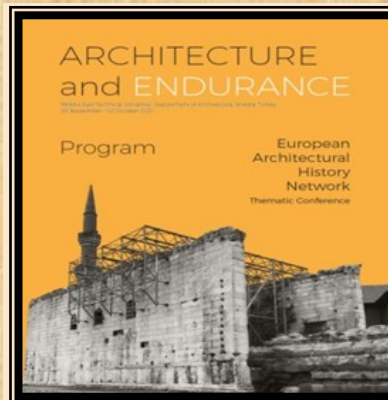

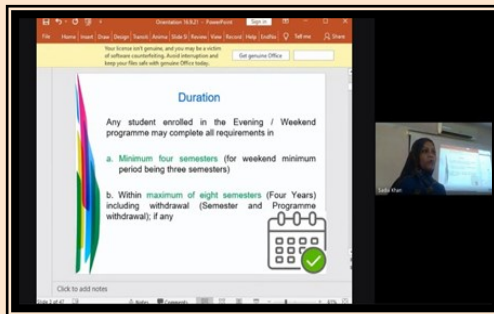
